



### Logo Competition for Skolasajf 2021

1. The subject of the competition is the creation of a Skolasajf logo.
2. The theme chosen for this year is '**AN I IN EVERY WINNER**'. This slogan aims to punctuate the importance that every individual has his own individual talents which can make him successful in his chosen path. Every person, whether children and adults, should be encouraged to cultivate their strengths, and to feel good about their abilities. Together we can contribute to be a winning team.
3. The competition is open to all children from 3 years onwards.
4. Each participant may submit *more* than one artwork.
5. The submitted artwork should be **the work of individual children**.
6. This year the competition is open on a national scale.
7. Children who attend Klabb 3-16 may submit their artwork to the Centre Coordinator, as a hard copy which should not be larger than A4 size.
8. Alternatively, submissions may be sent on [programmes.fes@gov.mt](mailto:programmes.fes@gov.mt)
9. Each artwork should bear the following details, whether it is submitted as a hard copy or as an email: **NAME, SURNAME, AGE, ID NUMBER, ADDRESS, CONTACT NUMBER/S OF PARENT/S, KLABB 3-16 CENTRE (if applicable)**.
10. The artwork must be in colour and should not include any dates.
11. Participants may use any media form in their artwork.
12. The closing date for the competition is **22<sup>nd</sup> January 2021**
13. The design which places first will be used as the official logo for Skolasajf 2021 and will become the property of the Foundation for Educational Services.
14. Centre Coordinators should encourage the children attending the Klabb 3-16 service to participate and create a logo, whether at the centre or at home. It would be nice if each centre were to submit at least one artwork, to have a representation from all the centres.
15. Winners will be notified by the end of February 2021. The award ceremony will be held in March 2021. The Foundation for Educational Services will be awarding the best three entries.
