Foreword

February was a time for celebrations, and the children at our Childcare and Klabb 3-16 centres celebrated by taking part in related activities, including Carnival. In the next few pages you will enjoy some of the lovely and colourful costumes modelled by the children. A big well done to all our dedicated staff who curated all the activities for the children.

While these celebrations were under way, the work in our centres continued in earnest, to inform the public about the service and to make the centres more conducive to build a learning environment.

The Childcare service is being continually strengthened, with the extension of hours in the selected centres being taken up by parents requiring a longer window of service. The remaining centres are also accepting registrations, so parents are encouraged to contact FES via its FB page, or the centres directly, to enquire about possible service hours.

In the meantime we are also continuing with our pledge for ongoing training of staff. The second cohort of Childcare Centre Coordinators are currently undergoing in-house training on the development and implementation of the Emergent Curriculum. This approach guides the planning and delivery of activities by focusing on being responsive to children's interests to create meaningful learning experiences. Training was also provided to 46 staff members in the subject of Pediatric First Aid.

While delivering all this, it is also full speed ahead on the planning for the Skolasajf 2023 service. The Skolasajf Logo Competition came to an end and we had our hands full trying to choose the first, second and third place winners, out of all the 292 submissions. This was a very hard decision as all the artworks and ideas were remarkable. We would like to thank all the students who took part.

While all the departments at Head Office are working according to their remit, of important highlight here is the number of Calls for Application for potential employees who would like to work during Skolasajf. **More details in the pages of this newsletter.**



HOW TO APPLY FOR OUR CHILD CARE SERVICES

1. Choose your preferred centre from the list found at:

You can also contact the chosen centre directly, ask for a tour of the place, and get the application directly from there.



Children can be registered at the centre by handing over to the Centre Coordinator, the filled-in application form together with the necessary documents. Only one application per child is to be submitted.

The Centre Coordinators and the FES FB Messenger service are always available to answer your queries. The Centre Coordinators will also be available to help you fill in the application form.

The childcare service is offered to children until they are eligible to move on to the government Kindergarten on the 1st of February, while children who are three years of age by the end of December are eligible for Kindergarten on the 1st of October, of that same calendar year.








Joanne Mifsud Name: Childcare Educator at Il-Merill Role: **Childcare Centre**

1. What do you think is the impact of the influence that you have as an educator on the children in your care?




TRAINING IN THE EMERGENT CURRICULUM
